VERTE SUMMER ACTIVITIES

'SEW ON & SEW FORTH WITH NATURE'

GUIDELINES

1. The main goal of this activity is to make the students use the different types of stitches that they have learnt, into a beautiful piece of work with the topic 'Environment' inculcated in their embroidery. It could be a scenery or nature etc. but your creativity must be put in your work.

(This activity is mandatory for all Verte members of grade IX)

The types of stitches that should be used are:

Running Stitch
Whipped Stitch
Laced Stitch
Couching Stitch
Back Stitch
Lazy-Daisy Stitch
Stem Stitch
Blanket Stitch
Fly Stitch
Chain Stitch
Bullion Stitch
Cross Stitch
French Knot
Caston Stitch

2. The above mentioned stitches are the ones that you have learnt. Minimum 7-8 stitches must be used in your work.

3. The material that you will stitch on must be above 15cmx15cm in size.

4. The embroidery must be done on a landscape piece of material.

TO SUBMIT YOUR WORK

- 1.You must take a time lapse of you doing the stitching on the material(it may take a few days you can edit the time lapse and compile the daily time lapse.)
 - 2.The time limit for the video must be 2 minutes.(video must be in landscape video)
 - 3.Submit your video latest by 20th July,2020.(you may even submit it once your done with your work)
- So put on your thinking caps and get started!
