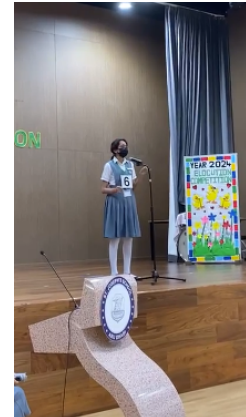


ELOCUTION EXTRAVAGANZA 2024-25
